

OPEN DOORS PROGRAM MAP: GED® (GENERAL EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT)

This pathway is for Open Doors enrolled students who are pursuing their GED®, which is a certificate of high school equivalency for individuals who have not completed high school. The exam consists of four separate tests, one for each of the following areas: Social Studies, Science, Mathematical Reasoning, and Reasoning through Language Arts (RLA).

BEFORE YOU START

- Email Open.Doors@Skagit.edu to begin the enrollment process
- Apply to SVC
- Take the CASAS Reading & Math placement test free of charge

IN YOUR FIRST QUARTER

- Connect with an advisor
- Set up account at www.ged.com.

IN YOUR SECOND QUARTER

- Explore the Areas of Study.
- Meet with your advisor to explore options for a high school diploma or college degree or certificate

IN YOUR FINAL QUARTER

- Create an educational plan for a high school diploma or college degree

SAMPLE SCHEDULE

Based on student placement, it will typically take one to three quarters to prepare to take all four GED tests. The sample schedule provided below will be tailored to meet the specific needs of each student.
